### **School meals**

In September the cost of a school meal for children in Years 3 – 6 will increase to £2.30 per meal. This is a decision made by our catering supplier, Integra.

In addition, the morning fruit from the kitchen will rise to 25p. The cost of a slice of toast with spread will remain at 10p.

Please note: if your child is moving into Year 3 in September, you will need to begin paying for school meals. The Government grant only exists for children in Reception, Year 1 & 2.
