

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: FEDERATED GOVERNING BODIES

- 1 The name of the Federation is **The Pinnacle Schools Federation**.
- 2 The names and categories of the schools in the Federation are:-

Hawkesbury Church of England Primary School
(Voluntary Controlled)

Iron Acton Church of England Primary School
(Voluntary Controlled)
- 3 The name of the governing body is “**The governing body of The Pinnacle Schools Federation**”.
- 4 The governing body shall consist of:
 - 2 Parent governors
 - 1 LA governor
 - 1 Staff governor
 - 1 Executive Head teacher
 - 7 Co-opted governors
 - 4 Foundation governors
- 5 Total number of governors **16**
- 6 The term of office of the staff governor is two years
The term of office of the co-opted governors is two years
- 7 One Foundation governor shall be appointed by Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with the Parochial Church Council of St Mary’s Hawkesbury.


One Foundation governor shall be nominated by the Parochial Church Council of Iron Acton and their appointment ratified by the Diocese of Bristol’s Board of Education
- 8 a. The holders of the following offices shall be a foundation governor
Ex-officio:

The principal officiating minister of the ecclesiastical parish of Hawkesbury

The incumbent of the Fromeside Benefice.

- b. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the schools are situated shall, on behalf of the relevant Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the offices named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which the governorship exists, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Constitution Regulations.
- 9 The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the schools are situated shall, on behalf of the relevant Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
- 10 A Trust exists which relates to Hawkesbury Church of England Primary School, the Trustees being the Vicar and Diocesan Trust
- A Trust exists which relates to Iron Acton Church of England Primary School, the Trustees being the Bristol Diocesan Board of Finance.
- 11 Ethos Statement:
- Hawkesbury and Iron Acton CE VC Primary Schools have a Christian Foundation, which they seek to promote by providing high quality education for all their pupils. Their ethos is underpinned by Christian values, which, by experience and example, provide a basis for lifelong learning where all children can flourish as part of a caring community.
12. This Instrument of Government came into effect on 1st September 2020.
